

The Lake County Drug Free Communities Fund

- Monies collected through the courts are held in a special county drug free communities fund by the county auditor;
- The Local Coordinating Council, Lake County Drug Free Alliance, is the administrator of these funds and is responsible for its distribution back out into the community;
- Based on needs and services identified by the LCC through its comprehensive planning process, which becomes the Comprehensive Community Plan, which has been approved by the Governor's Commission for a Drug Free Indiana, mini grants are allocated to agencies and entities on an annual basis.

Allocated by state statute:

25% Prevention and Education
25% Intervention and Treatment
25% Justice and Law Enforcement
25% distributed between 1-3 and administrative costs
